CADET PROGRAM PROFILE

The Crete Township Fire Protection District has supported a firefighting cadet program for over 5 years. Many of our Cadets have gone on to become Crete Township firefighters or work in related fields.

The main goal of the program is to get high school age kids the core values of being part of a team while learning job skills to support the community when fires or medical emergencies occur.

The Cadet program is designed to be a self supported program with the students leading the class and directed by seasoned firefighters and department officers. All skills taught are structured from the basic skills set by the Illinois State Fire Marshalls Office.

Teamwork is one of the main values which are implemented in every classroom and practical / hands-on topic.

Students will learn the basic skills which will assist them in future for certifications and possible full time firefighting careers.

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

Requirements for becoming a Crete Township Firefighting Cadet

- At least 15 years old, up to 18
- Enrolled in High School or Equivalent
- Maintain "C" Average
- Transportation To and From Fire House Classroom
- No Drug or Alcohol Usage
- Physical Fitness
- Good Attitude
- Willingness to Learn
- Desire to Participate in Para-Military Command Structure
- Available from 7pm to 10pm every Thursday Night
