**Deputy Chief:**

Written report was presented. Four members are attending the Fire Apparatus Engineer class at Prairie State College under the "Donated Fire Truck Agreement". CTFPD will be sending members and apparatus to assist with manning in South Holland during the wake/funeral for the South Holland firefighter/diver. Voting will be held at all three stations on Tuesday, November 3<sup>rd</sup>. HITS/Balmoral Race Track is attempting to lower their taxes with the Will County Tax Assessor. Two of the new evergreens will be replaced at Station #41 in the coming weeks.

**Old Business:** 

Discuss / Approve the Refurb with Frame Rail Replacement – Engine #43 Alexis/HME Pumper – Assistant Chief Swanson stated a revised quote was received from Alexis regarding the refurb with frame rail replacement on Engine #43. Additions include the following repairs: chassis rear axle seals will be changed, rusted battery boxes will be cleaned/prepped & repainted and the pump packing will be replaced & adjusted to specification. The engine was inspected by an Alexis mechanic who did not see any repairs out of the ordinary. It was advised any parts found to be decaying should be replaced while the apparatus is being repaired rather than later. The project would take approximately six months and payment is due upon completion. After much discussion, District Trustees agreed to go out to bid for the project later this fiscal year and begin the work next fiscal year. Trustee Miller requested Chief Panega verify the project will be included in the audit for the fiscal year the work is completed, not the fiscal year the project is approved.
