Fire Call Report: Written report presented - 140 calls were reported for the month of

September.

EMS Report: Written report presented. The new Lucas CPR device has been placed in

service on Ambulance #42. The Family and Friends CPR Class was cancelled due to lack of interest. All used and expiring medications have been replaced and are up to date. All members are current with their continuing education. Working on the completion of the IDPH EMS Letters

of Commitment for the state and Silver Cross.

Training Officer: Written report submitted. Listed are members who have completed trainings

and those working on completing outstanding trainings. September's Auto Aid Drill was live fire training with Beecher. October's drill will be basic company skills in Crete. Participated in MABAS 27 auto aid drill on October 3rd; one member was injured during the drill. Two members attended Nicor

natural gas fire training. A house has been acquired for training in the district. Four POC members will be graduating from the fire academy December 20th at 5pm.

Grant Summary:

No word has been received on the outstanding grant award notifications. Fire Prevention received a grant for supplies from State Farm Insurance.

Fire Prevention:

Written report submitted. Fire Prevention Open House was a success; good turnout from the public. An update was given on the Dixie Highway storage unit expansion. A variance request has been received from Will County for a two-foot easement, from the required five feet, for a metal shed at 25848 S. Cottage Grove. Notice was also received regarding the installation of a back-up generator at the cell phone tower on Klemme Road. No update on the three solar field projects.

Chief's Report:

Written report submitted. Four positions are filled on the six- person contract; one employee is off due to injury. Two part-time employees have been hired. Two new POC members have been added to the roster. ISO testing has been completed for the year, with the exception of inspections. Accident and ambulance billing are current. Hydro testing of the cascade bottles on Engine #43 and at Station #41 have been completed. It was reported Carol Sokoloski, a long-time member of the Auxiliary, passed away and was recognized for her service. Several CTFPD members, both past and present, paid their respect and participated in the Fire Department walk through for recently deceased Crete Fire Chief JP Muirhead.
