Treasurer's Report: Treasurer's Report was read by Trustee Peterlin. Motion to accept the Treasurer's Report by Trustee Miller. Second Trustee Zimmerman. Motion carried. (3-yes, 0-no)

Fire Call Report:

Written report presented - 126 calls were reported for the month of October.

EMS Report:

Written report presented. Work continues on catching up with quality control on old patient care reports. Company drill training for the month of October consisted of an EMS scenario with a full arrest utilizing the EMS training mannequin. Plans are to schedule a Heart Saver CPR class in January or February. A new refusal policy is being created utilizing guidelines set forth by Silver Cross and the State of Illinois.

Training Officer:

Written report submitted. Listed are members who have completed trainings and those working on completing outstanding trainings. Four POC members will graduate from the Fire Academy December 20th at 5pm. Two of the four have passed the Mod A test. Firefighter Sline received FSVO certification. Firefighter Stanford is scheduled to take the written test for FSVO. An Auto Aid Drill on fire ground operations was held in October with Beecher and Crete fire departments. MABAS 27 will host a live fire training in Beecher on November 28th.

Grant Summary:

A proposal for communication equipment has been submitted to LCC in regards to the \$50,000.00 awarded to the fire department through Will County. No word has been received on the remaining outstanding grant award notifications.

Fire Prevention:

Written report submitted. Village Woods is vacated of all residents. A meeting has taken place with management regarding required fire codes for the vacated premises. Balmoral Park is unable to find a company to glycol the sprinkler system; the system is still charged while they continue to look.

Chief's Report:

Written report submitted. Four positions are filled on the six-person Metro contract. The injured contract employee, reported last month, has been cleared to return to work without restrictions. One part-time employee has been hired. One new POC member has been added to the roster and will attend the fire academy this spring. Accident and ambulance billing are current. ISO testing has been completed for the year with the exception of inspections. A PO, in the amount of \$2,143.08, was submitted for approval to upgrade the firewalls at all three stations. An additional PO, in the amount

of \$2,355.97, was submitted for approval to repair the backflow preventer system at Station #42. Chief Radtke will be attending a meeting tomorrow regarding a review of the active shooter call at Crete Monee High School.
